TALKING POINTS TO SHARE WITH YOUR LEGISLATORS	WAYS TO FIND AND COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR LEGISLATORS
Please support the Kentucky Fair Maps Act, which creates an Advisory Redistricting Commission to draw Kentucky's new legislative district maps.	Use tinyurl.com/KyLegis as a shortcut to the site that lets you look up your Senator and Representative and find their contact information.
We don't want our state gerrymandered.	Then use one or all of these methods to urge your legislators to support the Fair Maps Act:
We don't want expensive court battles over redistricting.	 Good: Send email or US mail to the addresses on their official webpages.
 Hear our voices. Public input and concerns must be gathered before Kentucky sets new legislative districts. 	 Better: Call 1-800-372-7181 to leave them messages.
 Let us choose our legislators. You should not use your power to keep yourselves in power. Give us fair maps. 	Best of All: Speak to your legislators in person by attending their town halls, forums, and other events or by making an appointment to sit down and talk.
